

### Welcome to the National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS).

Now that you are registered with us, you can access a range of NDSS services such as diabetes education programs, resources and products at subsidised prices to help you manage your gestational diabetes.

### Your NDSS registration card is attached and is valid for 12 months.

- To access subsidised diabetes products through the NDSS take this card with you to an NDSS Access Point, usually your local community pharmacy. To find a community pharmacy in your area go to healthdirect.gov.au/search-results/pharmacy or call our NDSS Helpline on 1800 637 700.
- Please sign the back of your card. If you are a person under 15 years old or an adult receiving continuing care, your parent or carer should sign the card.
- You will need your card every time you order products or access services through the NDSS.

Enclosed is a booklet called *Gestational Diabetes: Caring for yourself and your baby* which provides information on managing gestational diabetes during your pregnancy.
