
## INSULIN THERAPY

## At 31 December 2013:


There were 344,948 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered on the NDSS. This was 31% of all people with diabetes

Diabetes Type	Number Requiring Insulin	% of Total	% of Diabetes Type
Type 1	116,719	34%	100%
Type 2	217,516	63%	23%
Gestational	7,879	2%	30%
Other	2,834	1%	49%
Total	344,948	100%	31%

## People With Diabetes Requiring Insulin by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 16,627 people were newly registered requiring insulin therapy: 3,037 with type 1 diabetes, 6,952 with type 2 diabetes, and 6,638 with gestational or other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 46 new insulin requiring registrants every day

63% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 34% had type 1 diabetes

217,516 people with type2 diabetes required insulin therapy

7,513 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

13,929 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

187,569 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
