



The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.


INSULIN THERAPY

At 31 March 2014:


There were 350,820 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered on the NDSS. This was 31% of all people with diabetes

Diabetes Type	Number Requiring Insulin	% of Total	% of Diabetes Type
Type 1	117,368	33%	100%
Type 2	222,334	63%	23%
Gestational	8,137	2%	30%
Other	2,981	1%	50%
Total	350,820	100%	31%

Over the last 12 months 16,577 people were newly registered requiring insulin therapy: 3,079 with type 1 diabetes, 6,650 with type 2 diabetes, and 6,848 with gestational or other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 45 new insulin requiring registrants every day

63% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 33% had type 1 diabetes

222,334 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

7,556 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

14,020 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

191,958 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
