

The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.

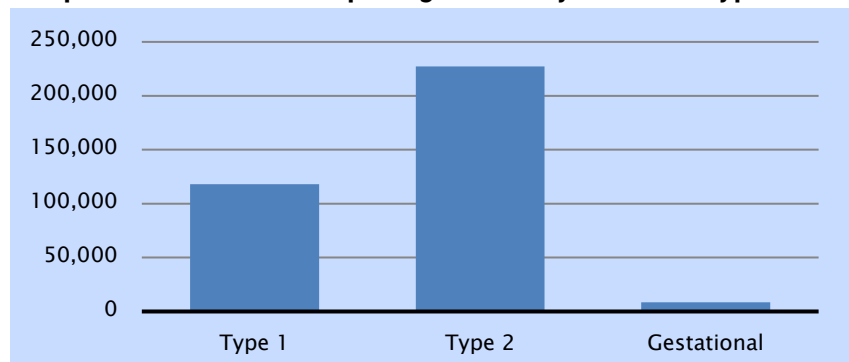
INSULIN THERAPY

At 30 June 2014

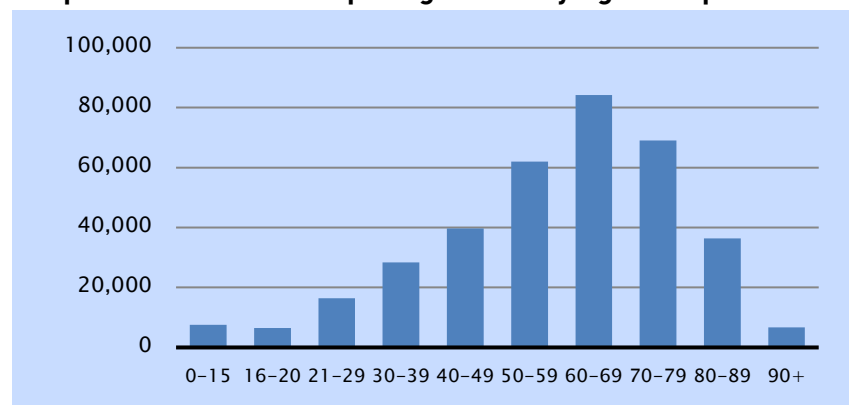
There were 356,807 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered on the NDSS. This was 31% of all people with diabetes

Type 2	227,375	64%	23%
Gestational	8,391	2%	30%
Other	3,102	1%	50%

Over the last 12 months 16,551 people were newly registered requiring insulin therapy: 3,021 with type 1 diabetes, 6,457 with type 2 diabetes, and 7,073 with gestational or other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 45 new insulin requiring registrants every day

64% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 33% had type 1 diabetes

227,375 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

7,559 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

14,055 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

196,366 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
