

The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.

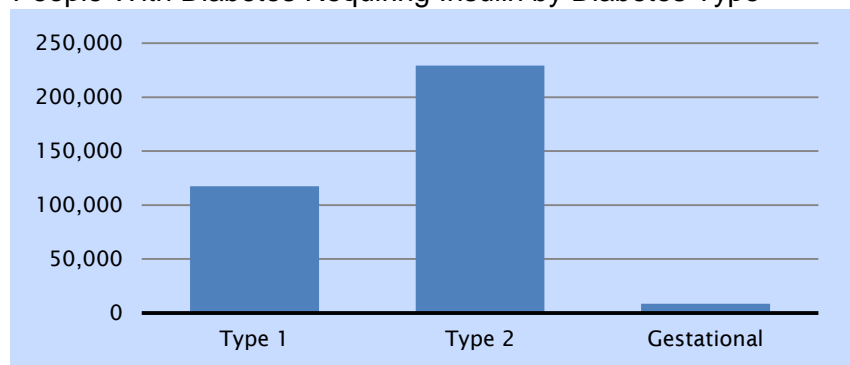
INSULIN THERAPY

At 30 September 2014

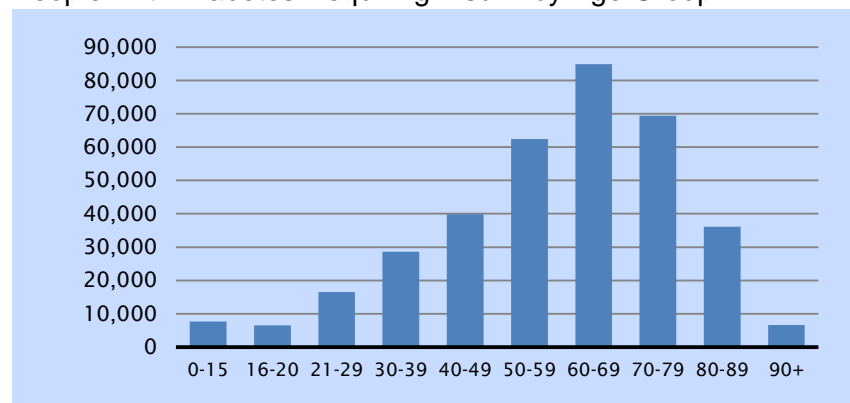
There were 358,656 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered on the NDSS. This was 31% of all people with diabetes

Type 1	117,415	33%	100%
Type 2	229,455	64%	23%
Gestational	8,637	2%	29%
Other	3,149	1%	51%
Total	358,656	100%	31%

Over the last 12 months 16,586 people were newly registered requiring insulin therapy: 2,989 with type 1 diabetes, 6,321 with type 2 diabetes, 6,681 with gestational diabetes, and 595 with other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 45 new insulin requiring registrants every day

64% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 33% had type 1 diabetes

229,455 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

7,616 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

14,146 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

197,036 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
