

The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.



People With Type 2 Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 67,398 people with type 2 diabetes were newly registered

Equivalent to 185 new registrants with type 2 diabetes every day

191 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 15 years or under

775 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 16 to 20 years old

5,341 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

670,561 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 60 years or older

229,455 people (23%) with type 2 diabetes required insulin to manage their diabetes
