## ALL TYPES OF DIABETES

At 31 December 2014

There were 1,156,180 people with diabetes registered on the NDSS

Gestational*	29,932	3%	30,205

\*An additional 70,672 women who previously had gestational diabetes are registered on the NDSS. These women are at high risk of developing type 2 diabetes and receive regular reminder letters to have a diabetes check.
