

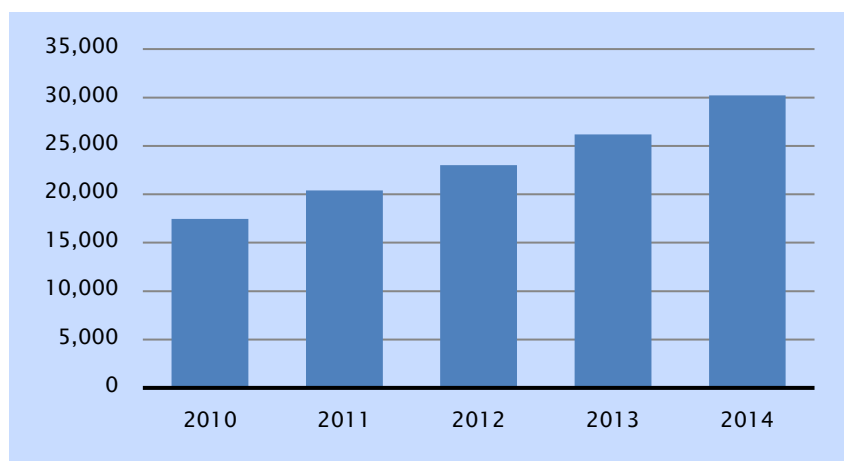

## GESTATIONAL DIABETES

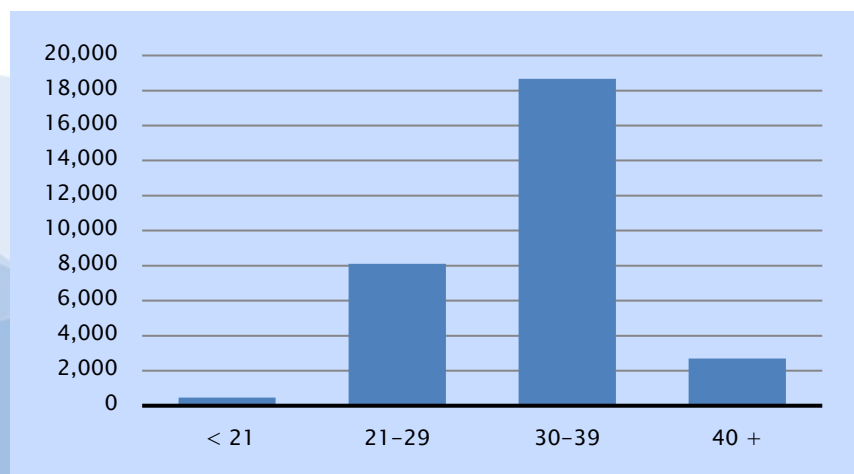
At 31 December 2014

30,205 women were registered in the last 12 months with gestational diabetes on the NDSS

### Women With Gestational Diabetes by Age Group



83 women with gestational diabetes were registered every day

The annual number of women registering with gestational diabetes increased by 15% in the 12 months ending December 2014

Of those women registered in the last 12 months 4,918 were registering with a repeat diagnosis of gestational diabetes during a following pregnancy

26,418 women registered with gestational diabetes were aged under 40 years old and 3,787 were aged 40 years or older

8,819 women (29%) currently registered with gestational diabetes required insulin to manage their diabetes

An additional 70,672 women previously diagnosed with gestational diabetes are receiving reminder letters to have a check for type 2 diabetes
