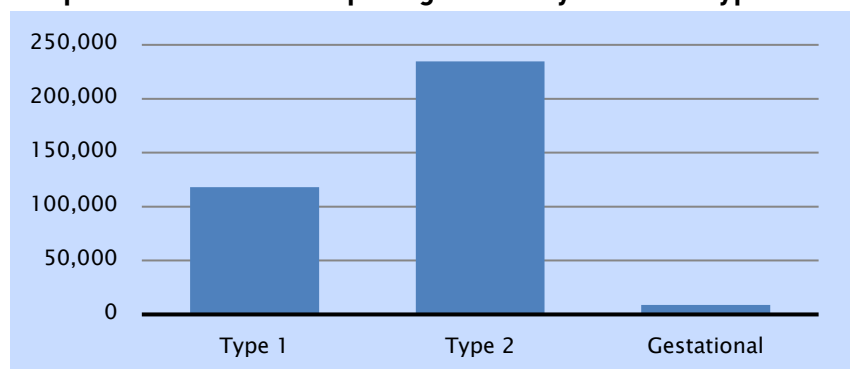
## INSULIN THERAPY

At 31 December 2014

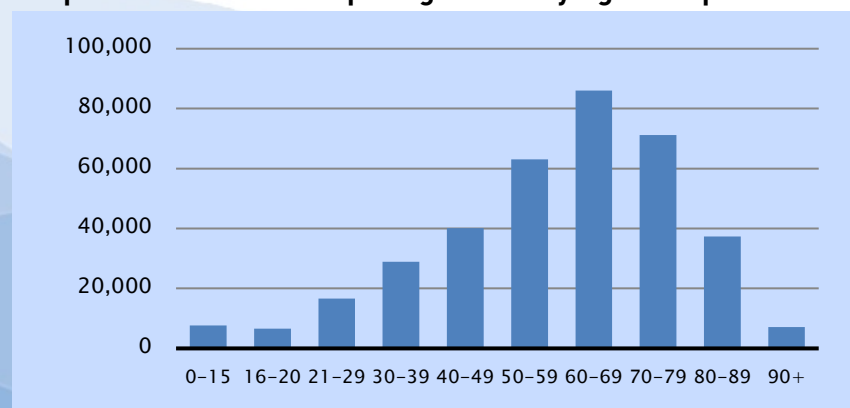
There were 364,596 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered on the NDSS. This was 32% of all people with diabetes

Diabetes Type	Requiring Insulin	% of Total	% of Diabetes Type
Type 1	117,886	32%	100%
Type 2	234,590	65%	23%
Gestational	8,819	2%	29%
Other	3,301	<1%	51%

Over the last 12 months 16,739 people were newly registered requiring insulin therapy: 2,964 with type 1 diabetes, 6,309 with type 2 diabetes, 6,844 with gestational diabetes, and 622 with other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 46 new insulin requiring registrants every day

64% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 32% had type 1 diabetes

234,590 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

7,628 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

14,200 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

201,647 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
