
At 31 March 2015

There were 1,160,728 people with diabetes registered on the NDSS

Diabetes Type	Number	%	Registered in Past Year
Type 1	117,442	10%	2,950
Type 2	1,005,624	86%	65,794
Gestational*	31,194	3%	31,194
Other	6,468	<1%	946
Total	1,160,728	100%	100,884

^{*} An additional 76,926 women who previously had gestational diabetes are registered on the NDSS. These women are at high risk of developing type 2 diabetes and receive regular reminder letters to have a diabetes check.

All People With Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 100,884 people with diabetes were newly registered

Equivalent to 276 new registrants every day

180 new registrants had type 2 diabetes and 8 had type 1 diabetes

7,973 people with diabetes were aged 15 years or under

15,565 people with diabetes were aged 20 years or under

26,861 people with diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

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
