

The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.

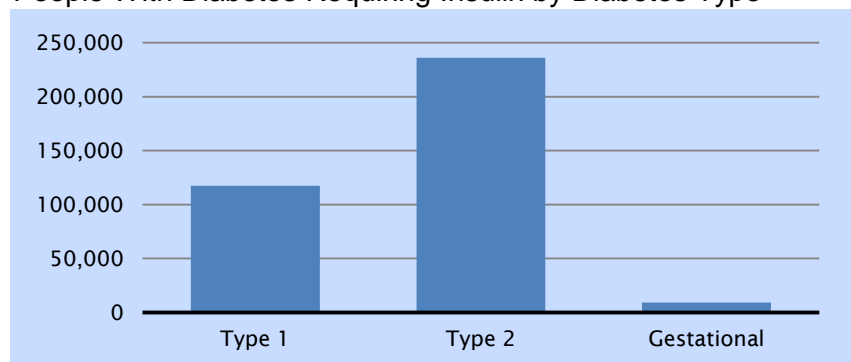
INSULIN THERAPY

At 31 March 2015

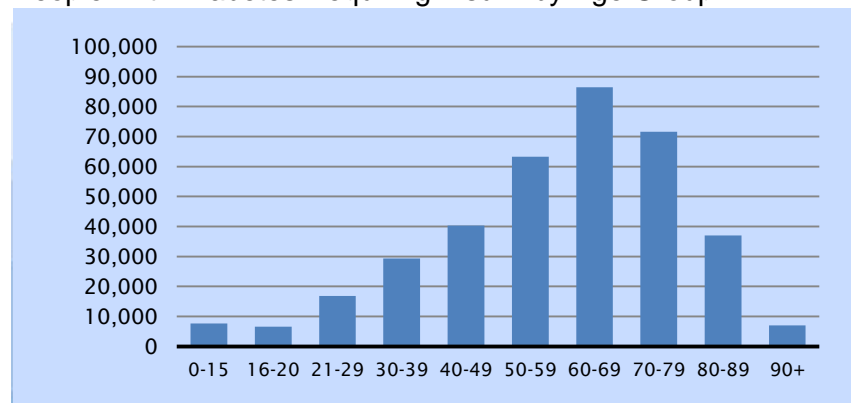
There were 366,000 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered on the NDSS. This was 32% of all people with diabetes

Type 1	117,442	32%	100%
Type 2	236,039	64%	23%
Gestational	9,185	3%	29%
Other	3,334	<1%	52%
Total	366,000	100%	32%

Over the last 12 months 19,083 people were newly registered requiring insulin therapy: 2,950 with type 1 diabetes, 6,337 with type 2 diabetes, 9,185 with gestational diabetes, and 611 with other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 52 new insulin requiring registrants every day

64% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 32% had type 1 diabetes

236,039 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

7,625 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

14,207 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

202,098 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
