## ALL TYPES OF DIABETES

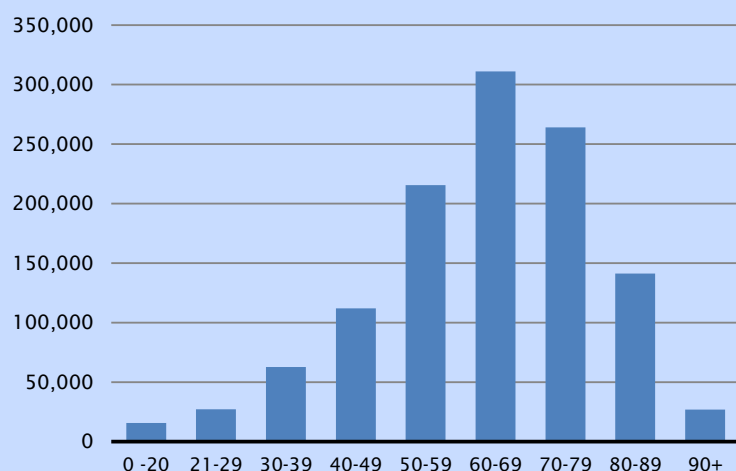
At 30 June 2015

There were 1,176,180 people with diabetes registered on the NDSS

Type 1	117,917	10%	2,973
Type 2	1,019,708	86%	65,463
Gestational*	31,890	3%	31,890
Other	6,665	< 1%	932
<b>Total</b>	<b>1,176,180</b>	<b>100%</b>	<b>101,258</b>

\* An additional 83,024 women who previously had gestational diabetes are registered on the NDSS. These women are at high risk of developing type 2 diabetes and receive regular reminder letters to have a diabetes check.
