

The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.

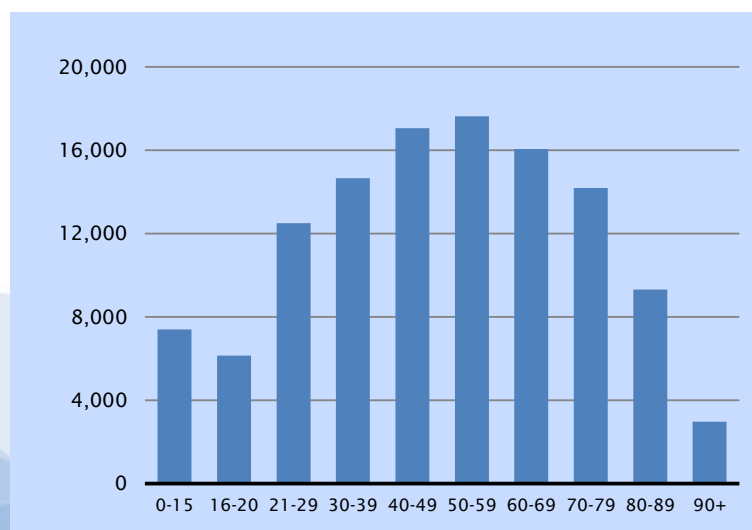
## TYPE 1 DIABETES

There were 117,917 people with type 1 diabetes registered on the NDSS

People With Type 1 Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 2,973 people with type 1 diabetes were newly registered

Equivalent to 8 new registrants with type 1 diabetes every day

7,404 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 15 years or under

13,552 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 20 years or under

12,500 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

14,655 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 30 to 39 years old

77,210 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 40 years or older

42,527 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 60 years or older

100% of people with type 1 diabetes required insulin to manage their diabetes
