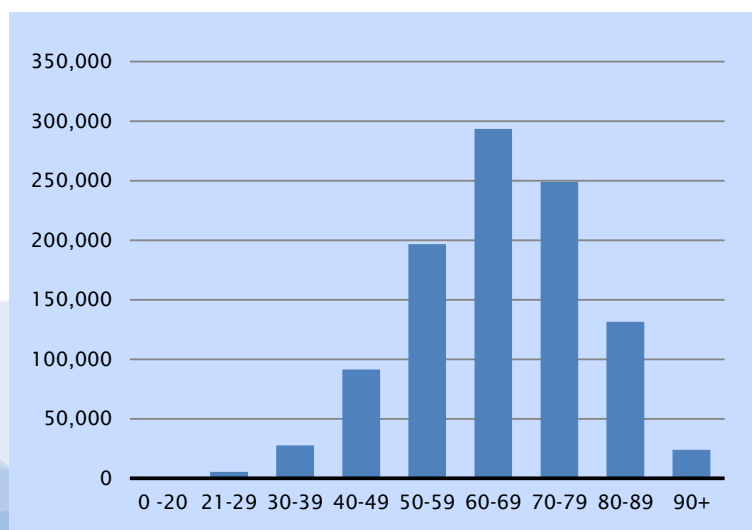
## TYPE 2 DIABETES

At 30 June 2015

There were 1,019,708 people with type 2 diabetes registered on the NDSS

| Age Group    | Number           | %           |
|--------------|------------------|-------------|
| 0 – 20       | 962              | < 1%        |
| 21 – 39      | 33,069           | 3%          |
| 40 – 59      | 288,016          | 28%         |
| 60 +         | 697,661          | 68%         |
| <b>Total</b> | <b>1,019,708</b> | <b>100%</b> |

People With Type 2 Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 65,463 people with type 2 diabetes were newly registered

Equivalent to 179 new registrants with type 2 diabetes every day

215 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 15 years or under

747 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 16 to 20 years old

5,470 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

288,016 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 40 to 59 years old

697,661 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 60 years or older

240,400 people (24%) with type 2 diabetes required insulin to manage their diabetes
