

## There were 1,176,961 people with diabetes registered on the NDSS

Diabetes Type	Number	%	Registered in Past Year
Type 1	117,423	10%	3,064
Type 2	1,020,219	86%	64,359
Gestational*	32,634	3%	32,634
Other	6,685	< 1%	901
Total	1,176,961	100%	100,958

<sup>\*</sup> An additional 89,168 women who previously had gestational diabetes are registered on the NDSS. These women are at high risk of developing type 2 diabetes and receive regular reminder letters to have a diabetes check.

## All People With Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 100,958 people with diabetes were newly registered

Equivalent to 277 new registrants every day

176 new registrants had type 2 diabetes and 8 had type 1 diabetes

8,098 people with diabetes were aged 15 years or under

15,819 people with diabetes were aged 20 years or under

27,744 people with diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

63,453 people with diabetes were aged 30 to 39 years old

742,088 people with diabetes were aged 60 years or older
