




The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.

GESTATIONAL DIABETES


At 30 September 2015

32,634 women were registered in the last 12 months with gestational diabetes on the NDSS

Women Registered in Last 12 Months With Gestational Diabetes



Women With Gestational Diabetes by Age Group



89 women with gestational diabetes were registered every day

The annual number of women registering with gestational diabetes increased by 14% in the 12 months ending September 2015

Of those women registered in the last 12 months 4,941 were registering with a repeat diagnosis of gestational diabetes during a following pregnancy

29,952 women registered with gestational diabetes were aged under 40 years old and 2,682 were aged 40 years or older

9,523 women (29%) currently registered with gestational diabetes required insulin to manage their diabetes

An additional 89,168 women who previously had gestational diabetes are receiving reminder letters to have a check for type 2 diabetes
