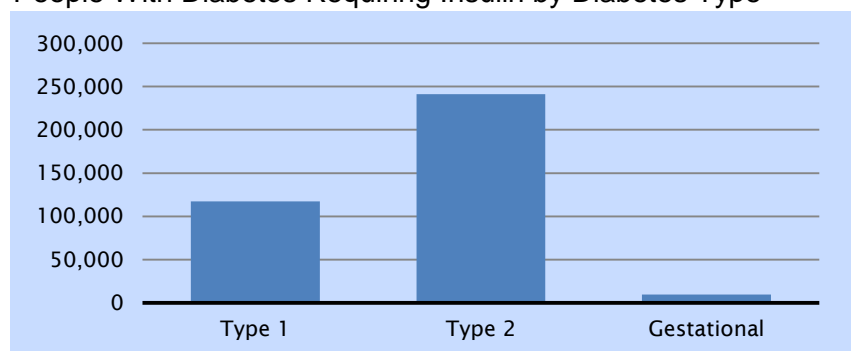
## INSULIN THERAPY

At 30 September 2015

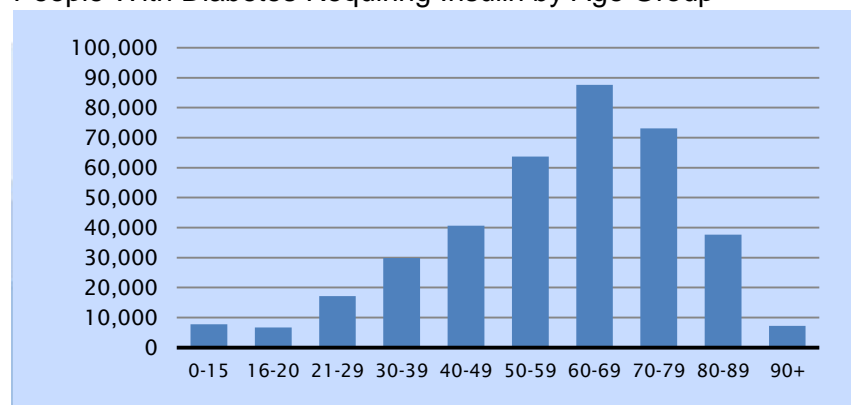
There were 371,605 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered on the NDSS. This was 32% of all people with diabetes

Type 2	241,157	64%	24%
Gestational	9,523	3%	29%
Other	3,502	< 1%	52%

Over the last 12 months 19,410 people were newly registered requiring insulin therapy: 3,064 with type 1 diabetes, 6,260 with type 2 diabetes, 9,523 with gestational diabetes and 563 with other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 53 new insulin requiring registrants every day

64% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 32% had type 1 diabetes

241,157 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

7,749 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

14,419 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

205,725 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
