
At 31 December 2015

There were 1,192,927 people with diabetes registered on the NDSS

Diabetes Type	Number	%	Registered in Past Year
Type 1	118,061	10%	3,135
Type 2	1,034,498	86%	62,990
Gestational*	33,480	3%	33,480
Other	6,888	< 1%	887
Total	1,192,927	100%	100,492

^{*} An additional 95,565 women who previously had gestational diabetes are registered on the NDSS. These women are at high risk of developing type 2 diabetes and receive regular reminder letters to have a diabetes check.

All People With Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 100,492 people with diabetes were registered

Equivalent to 275 new registrants every day

Of these, 173 new registrants had type 2 diabetes and 9 had type 1

8,080 people with diabetes were aged 15 years or under

15,803 people with diabetes were aged 20 years or under

28,176 people with diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

64,318 people with diabetes were aged 30 to 39 years old

755,508 people with diabetes were aged 60 years or older
