

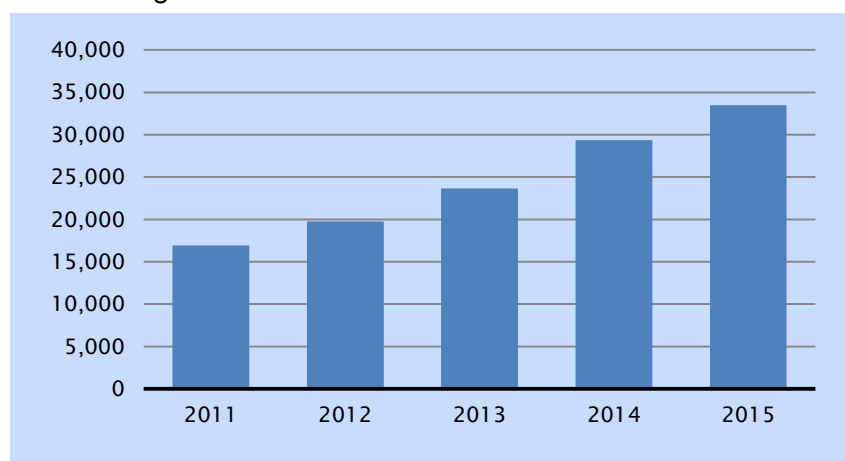

# GESTATIONAL DIABETES

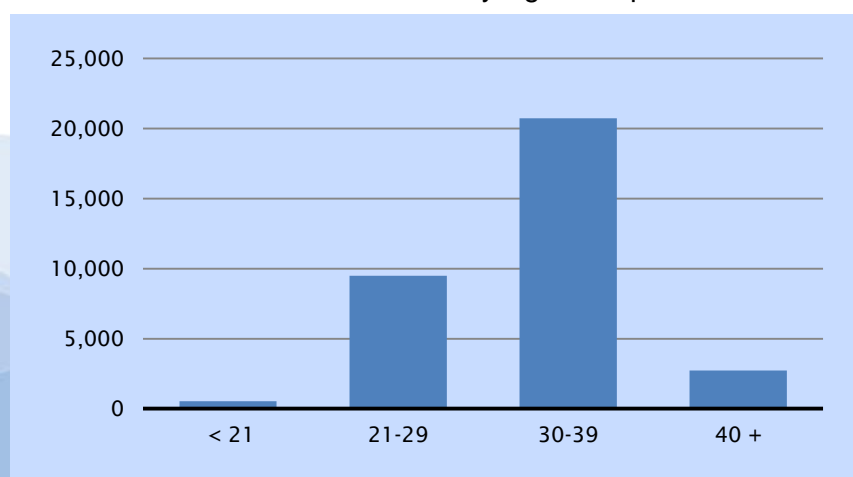
At 31 December 2015

33,480 women were registered in the last 12 months with gestational diabetes on the NDSS

Women Registered in Last 12 Months With Gestational Diabetes



Women With Gestational Diabetes by Age Group



92 women with gestational diabetes were registered every day

The annual number of women registering with gestational diabetes increased by 14% in the 12 months ending December 2015

Of those women registered in the last 12 months 5,105 were registering with a repeat diagnosis of gestational diabetes during a following pregnancy

30,741 women registered with gestational diabetes were aged under 40 years old and 2,739 were aged 40 years or older

9,813 women (29%) currently registered with gestational diabetes required insulin to manage their diabetes

An additional 95,565 women who previously had gestational diabetes are receiving reminder letters to have a check for type 2 diabetes
