

The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.

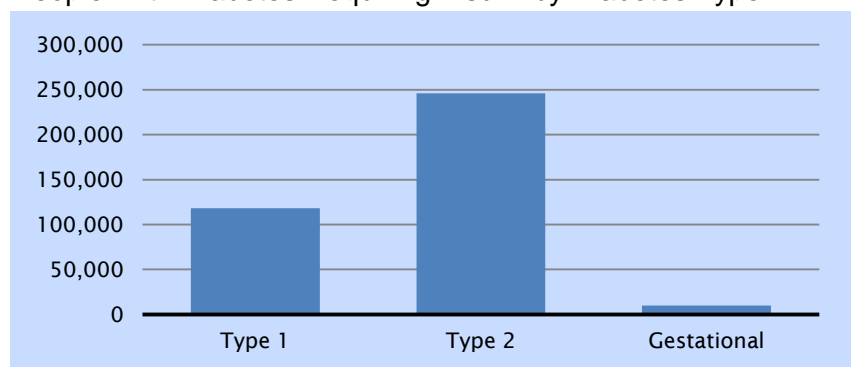
INSULIN THERAPY

At 31 December 2015

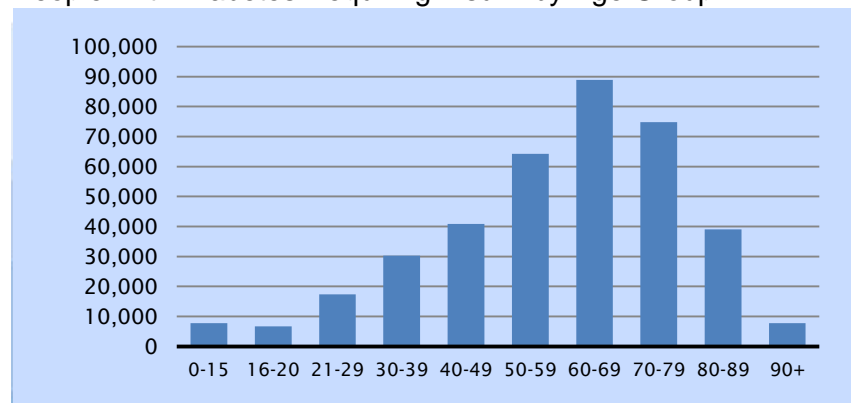
There were 377,676 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered on the NDSS. This was 32% of all people with diabetes

Type 1	118,061	31%	100%
Type 2	246,126	65%	24%
Gestational	9,813	3%	29%
Other	3,676	< 1%	53%
Total	377,676	100%	32%

Over the last 12 months 19,717 people were registered requiring insulin therapy: 3,135 with type 1 diabetes, 6,212 with type 2 diabetes, 9,813 with gestational diabetes, and 557 with other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 54 new insulin requiring registrants every day

65% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 31% had type 1 diabetes

246,126 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

7,742 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

14,428 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

210,541 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
