

The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.

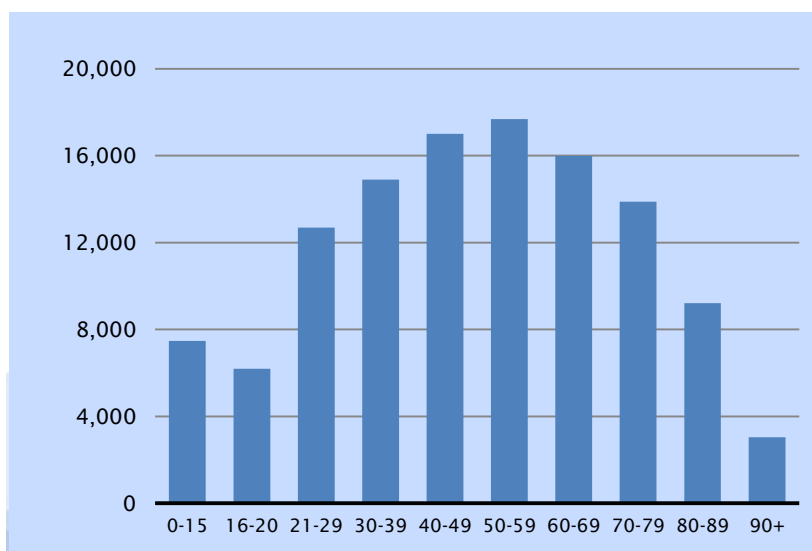

There were 118,061 people with type 1 diabetes registered on the NDSS

| Age Group | Number | % |
|--------------|----------------|-------------|
| 0 – 20 | 13,673 | 12% |
| 21 – 39 | 27,581 | 23% |
| 40 – 59 | 34,683 | 29% |
| 60 + | 42,124 | 36% |
| Total | 118,061 | 100% |

People With Type 1 Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 3,135 people with type 1 diabetes were registered

Equivalent to 9 new registrants with type 1 diabetes every day

7,479 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 15 years or under

13,673 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 20 years or under

12,687 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

14,894 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 30 to 39 years old

76,807 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 40 years or older

42,124 people with type 1 diabetes were aged 60 years or older

100% of people with type 1 diabetes required insulin to manage their diabetes
