
At 31 March 2016

There were 1,196,121 people with diabetes registered on the NDSS

Diabetes Type	Number	%	Registered in Past Year
Type 1	117,319	10%	3,138
Type 2	1,036,819	86%	61,430
Gestational*	34,955	3%	34,955
Other	7,028	< 1%	924
Total	1,196,121	100%	100,447

^{*} An additional 102,555 women who previously had gestational diabetes are registered on the NDSS. These women are at high risk of developing type 2 diabetes and receive regular reminder letters to have a diabetes check.

All People With Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 100,447 people with diabetes were registered

Equivalent to 275 new registrants every day

Of these, 168 new registrants had type 2 diabetes and 9 had type 1

8,111 people with diabetes were aged 15 years or under

15,853 people with diabetes were aged 20 years or under

28,616 people with diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

65,679 people with diabetes were aged 30 to 39 years old

756,277 people with diabetes were aged 60 years or older
