

The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.

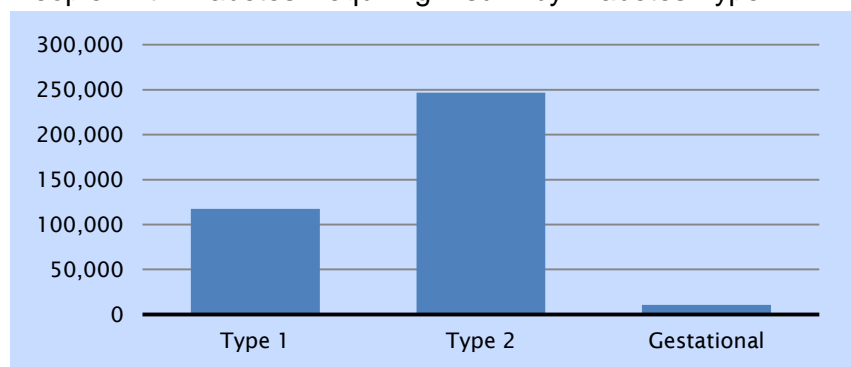
INSULIN THERAPY

At 31 March 2016

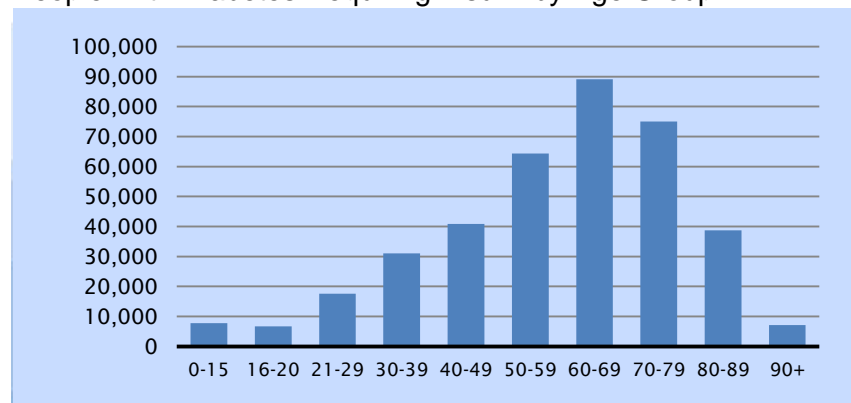
There were 378,349 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered on the NDSS. This was 32% of all people with diabetes

Type 1	117,319	31%	100%
Type 2	246,834	65%	24%
Gestational	10,414	3%	30%
Other	3,782	< 1%	54%
Total	378,349	100%	32%

Over the last 12 months 20,382 people were registered requiring insulin therapy: 3,138 with type 1 diabetes, 6,251 with type 2 diabetes, 10,414 with gestational diabetes, and 579 with other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 56 new insulin requiring registrants every day

65% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 31% had type 1 diabetes

246,834 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

7,758 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

14,461 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

210,061 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
