

The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.

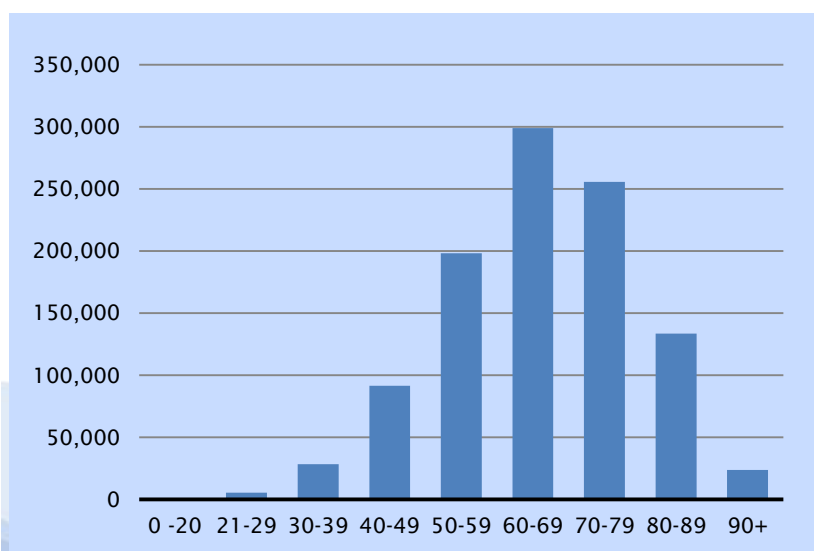
## TYPE 2 DIABETES

There were 1,036,819 people with type 2 diabetes registered on the NDSS

People With Type 2 Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 61,430 people with type 2 diabetes were registered

Equivalent to 168 new registrants with type 2 diabetes every day

220 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 15 years or under

727 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 16 to 20 years old

5,596 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

290,016 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 40 to 59 years old

711,950 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 60 years or older

246,834 people (24%) with type 2 diabetes required insulin to manage their diabetes
