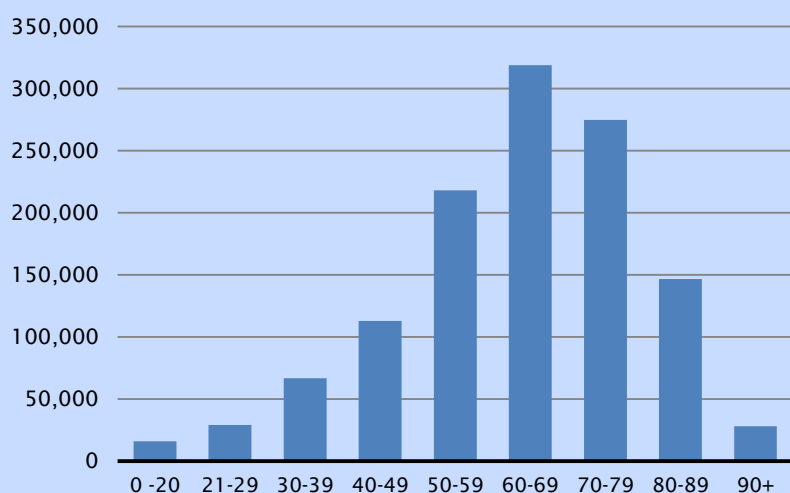

Type 2	1,049,929	86%	59,860
Gestational*	36,198	3%	36,198
Other	7,249	< 1%	916
Total	1,211,251	100%	100,105

* An additional 109,077 women who previously had gestational diabetes are registered on the NDSS. These women are at high risk of developing type 2 diabetes and receive regular reminder letters to have a diabetes check.
