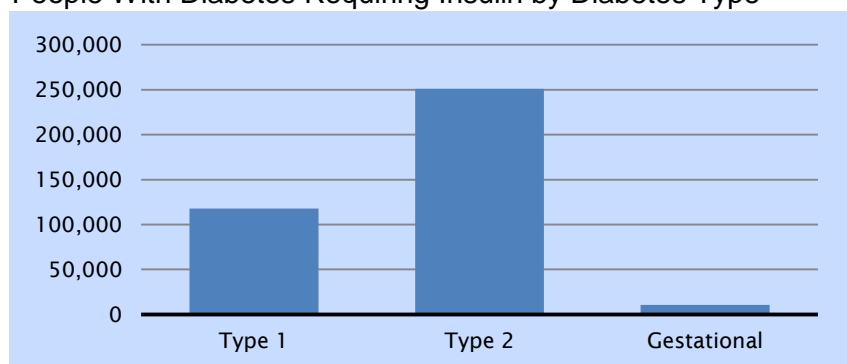
# INSULIN THERAPY

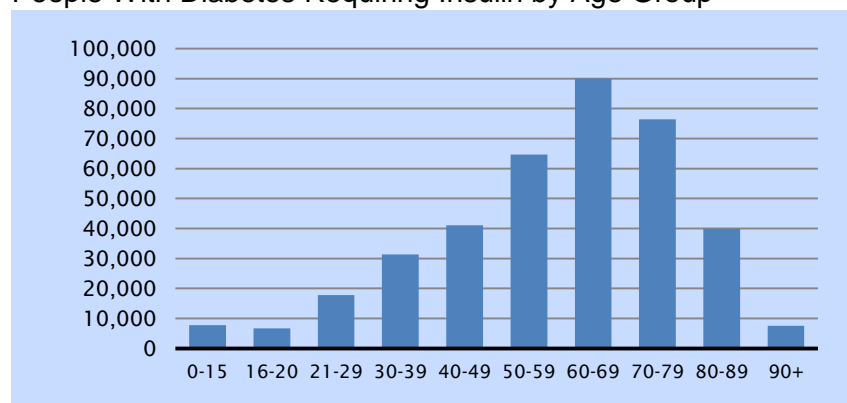
There were 383,439 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered on the NDSS. This was 32% of all people with diabetes

Gestational	10,648	3%	29%
Other	3,966	1%	55%

Over the last 12 months 20,690 people were registered requiring insulin therapy: 3,131 with type 1 diabetes, 6,299 with type 2 diabetes, 10,648 with gestational diabetes, and 612 with other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 57 new insulin requiring registrants every day

65% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 31% had type 1 diabetes

250,950 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

7,780 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

14,504 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

213,955 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
