

There were 1,231,519 people with diabetes registered on the NDSS

Type 1	118,671	10%	3,144
Type 2	1,068,073	86%	63,030
Gestational*	37,285	3%	37,285
Other	7,490	< 1%	983
Total	1,231,519	100%	104,442

^{*} An additional 115,690 women who previously had gestational diabetes are registered on the NDSS. These women are at high risk of developing type 2 diabetes and receive regular reminder letters to have a diabetes check.

All People With Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 104,442 people with diabetes were registered

Equivalent to 286 new registrants every day

Of these, 173 new registrants had type 2 diabetes and 9 had type 1 diabetes

8,179 people with diabetes were aged 15 years or under

16,272 people with diabetes were aged 20 years or under

29,602 people with diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

67,993 people with diabetes were aged 30 to 39 years old

784,575 people with diabetes were aged 60 years or older
