

The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.


INSULIN THERAPY


There were 391,502 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered on the NDSS. This was 32% of all people with diabetes

Type 2	257,660	66%	24%
Gestational	10,855	3%	29%
Other	4,175	1%	55%
Total	391,502	100%	32%

Over the last 12 months 21,031 people were registered requiring insulin therapy: 3,145 with type 1 diabetes, 6,417 with type 2 diabetes, 10,855 with gestational diabetes, and 614 with other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 58 new insulin requiring registrants every day

66% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 30% had type 1 diabetes

257,660 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

7,756 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

14,761 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

220,225 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
