Over the last 12 months 106,794 people with diabetes were registered

Equivalent to 293 new registrants every day

Of these, 177 new registrants had type 2 diabetes and 9 had type 1 diabetes

8,260 people with diabetes were aged 15 years or under

16,347 people with diabetes were aged 20 years or under

30,022 people with diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

70,075 people with diabetes were aged 30 to 39 years old

805,405 people with diabetes were aged 60 years or older
