

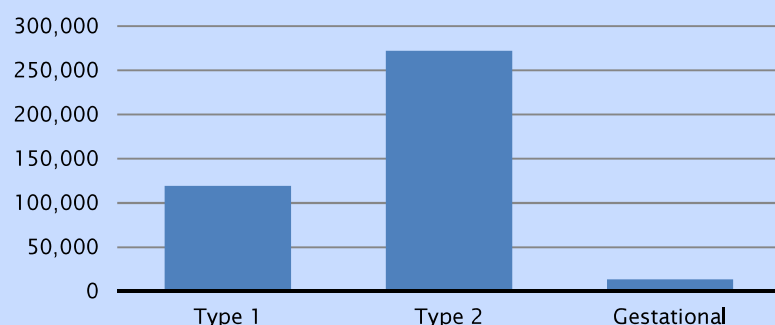
# INSULIN THERAPY

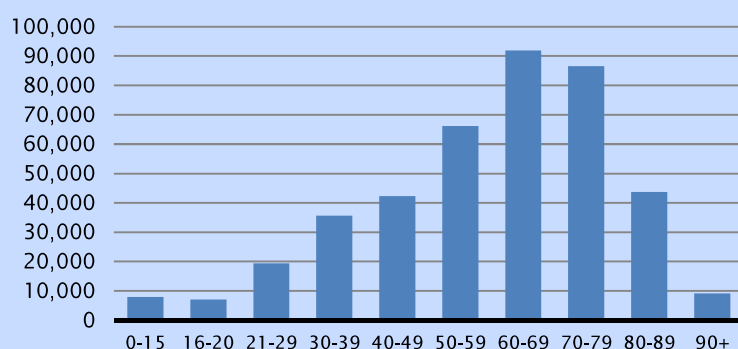
There were 409,972 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered with the NDSS. This was 32% of all people with diabetes

Type 1	119,359	29%	100%
Type 2	271,960	67%	24%
Gestational	13,782	3%	34%
Other	4,871	1%	57%

Over the last 12 months 23,990 people were registered requiring insulin therapy: 3,177 with type 1 diabetes, 6,297 with type 2 diabetes, 13,782 with gestational diabetes, and 734 with other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 66 new insulin requiring registrants every day

67% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 29% had type 1 diabetes

271,960 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

8,015 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

15,124 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

231,303 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
