

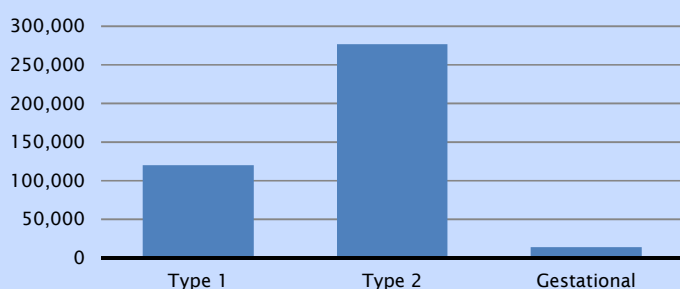
INSULIN THERAPY

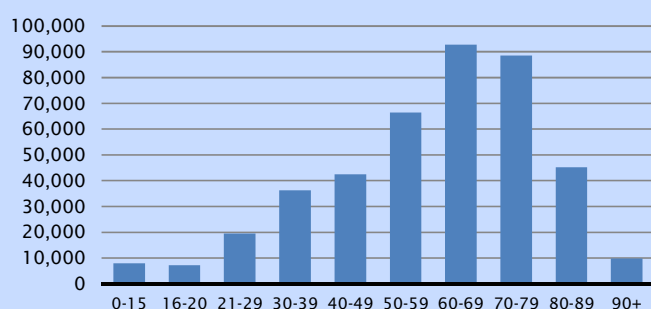
There were 416,161 people with diabetes who required insulin therapy registered with the NDSS. This was 32% of all people with diabetes

| Diabetes Type | Requiring Insulin | % of Total | % of Diabetes Type |
|---------------|-------------------|-------------|--------------------|
| Type 1 | 120,159 | 29% | 100% |
| Type 2 | 276,672 | 67% | 24% |
| Gestational | 14,295 | 3% | 35% |
| Other | 5,035 | 1% | 57% |
| Total | 416,161 | 100% | 32% |

Over the last 12 months 24,480 people were registered requiring with the NDSS insulin therapy: 3,237 with type 1 diabetes, 6,221 with type 2 diabetes, 14,295 with gestational diabetes, and 727 with other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 67 new insulin requiring registrants every day

67% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 29% had type 1 diabetes

276,672 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

8,015 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

15,154 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

236,250 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
